

**Lincoln County Joint Lincoln County and City of Sioux Falls Planning Commission
Meeting Minutes
July 10, 2024**

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The joint meeting of the Lincoln County Planning Commission and the City of Sioux Falls Planning Commission was called to order by Acting Chairperson Jongeling on July 10, 2024 at 6:32 p.m. in the Commissioner's Meeting Room of the Lincoln County Courthouse. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- 1) **Application:** USE-0048-2024: Conditional use permit to exceed 1,200 square feet of total accessory building space (requesting 2,223 cumulative square feet) on the property legally described as Lot 5, Hanson's Second Addition, SW1/4, Section 16-T100N-R49W Springdale Township.

Toby Brown introduced the application and presented a brief summary of the staff report. The Planning Commission asked staff questions regarding enforcement of conditions. 1. Before occupancy, all site development is to comply with the applicable lot requirements.
2. The accessory building shall only be used for the storage of personal property, and no commercial uses and commercial storage shall take place.
3. The accessory building may not be used for dwelling purposes.
4. There shall be no indication of offensive noise, odor, smoke, dust or glare at or beyond the property line.
5. The permit holder is responsible for compliance with all Federal, State, and Local rules, regulations, and permitting requirements.

A roll call vote was taken. Yeas: Sweeter, Jongeling, Boots, Green and Schmidt. Nays: None. Motion carried. A motion was made for the City by Commissioner Nyberg and seconded by Commissioner Mullaly to approve the application with the same conditions. A voice vote was taken. Yeas: All. Nays: None.
