COMMISSIONER DISCUSSION: Tom Wollman, State's Attorney for Lincoln County, presented an in-depth look at the State's Attorney's Office, and covered what happened in 2025 and projections for 2026 and beyond. No public input was heard.

COMMISSIONER DISCUSSION: Steve Swenson, Lincoln County Sheriff, gave a department presentation to the Board regarding the activities of the Sheriff's Office, Jail and 911/Communications. No public input was heard.

Chairman Landeen left the meeting at 10:45 am. Commissioner Schmidt then served as Board Chair for the remainder of the meeting.

COMMISSIONER BRIEFING: Steve Swenson, Lincoln County Sheriff, asked the Board for authorization to purchase a bus chassis for the jail division at a cost not to exceed \$86,000. The current bus, used for transporting inmates, is not a safe option due to lack of space. No public input was heard.
